Start a youth out on his way; even when he grows old he will not depart from it.



Jesus said , "Leave the children alone, and don't try to keep them from coming to me, because the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."




In the beginning, God made them male and female. That's what He did then, is doing now, and will always do.

God made the male body and the female


body to look differently.


Females should not wear clothes made for males, and males should not wear clothes made for females. This is wrong, and God calls this a sin.
